ORDINANCE 03.16

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ODEBOLT, IOWA:

Title VI PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT Chapter 6-Utilities- Billing Charges. 6-6-10 rate of Sewer Rent & Manner of Payment City Code of Odebolt, Iowa, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 6-6-10 Chapter is hereby repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:
RATE OF SEWER RENT AND MANNER OF PAYMENT.

The rate of sewer rent shall be based upon the net water bill for each premise. The rent shall be paid with the water bill at the same time as payment of the water bill is due and under the same condition as to penalty for late payment, at the office of the City Clerk, beginning with the next payment after the enactment of this Ordinance, or, if connection has not been made, after the connection to the sewer system is made.

1. The sewer rent rate follows:

First 1,000 gallons of water used over the monthly billing period will be charged at \$14.84 (which will keep our compliance with SRF loans at 1.9. It has to be at least 1.1 to be compliant)

1st reading on May 4, 2016

2nd reading and dispense with final reading on June 6, 2016

After full and complete discussion it was moved by Council member Hemer that said ordinance be brought on for consideration and that the rules requiring that an ordinance received and filed at two meetings prior to the meeting when final action is taken, or if published in summary be received and filed at one meeting prior to the meeting of the final action be dispensed with. Said motion was seconded by Council member Mohr.

The mayor then declared the motion carried by three-fourths vote, as required by the Statutes of Iowa, and the rules dispensed with.
